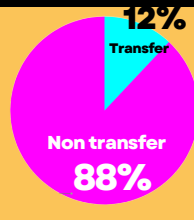
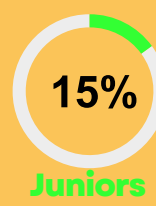
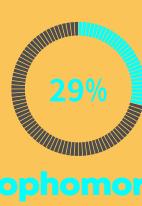
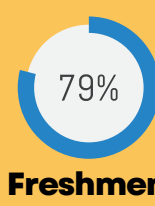
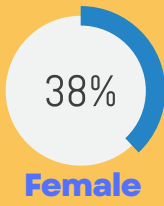
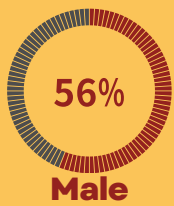


Res Life Experience: By The Numbers

Points of Pride

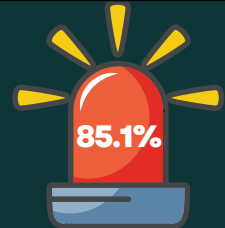
Percentage of students indicating 6 or 7 on a 7 pt. scale

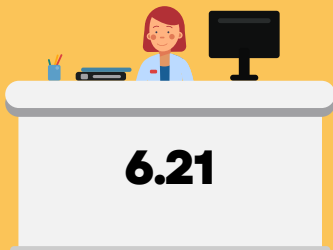
